RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Numbers will be issued upon presentation of proof of current negative Coggins (Swamp Fever) test. PLEASE INCLUDE TEST DATE AND ACCESSION NUMBER IN THE DESIGNATED PLACE ON THE ENTRY FORM. A copy of current Coggins attached to entry form will be accepted. THIS INFORMATION IS TO BE PUT ON EACH AND EVERY ENTRY FORM FOR EACH AND EVERY SHOW!!!!. ALL NON-SHOWING HORSES MUST HAVE AND PRODUCE NEGATIVE COGGINS.
2. ENTRY FEES MUST ACCOMPANY REGISTRATION. No pre-entries will be accepted after MAR. 19th for the MARCH show and APR. 16th for the APRIL show. NO ENTRIES WILL BE TAKEN OVER THE PHONE. Pre-entry fee \$8.00 per class. Post-entry fee is \$15.00 per class and will be charged on all entries received after the due date. All class alterations \$3.00 per class (Change to another class; change rider's name; change horse's name, etc.) JUMPER PRE-ENTRY FEE IS \$20.00. POST-ENTRY IS \$30.00. ENTRY FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.
3. STALL FEES ARE \$25.00 for 1 day and \$35.00 for 2 days STALL FEES ARE NOT REFUNDABLE AND MUST BE PAID BY THE DUE DATE. **NO STALL WILL BE HELD WITHOUT PAYMENT.** NO STALL OR SHAVINGS FEES WILL BE REFUNDED OR MOVED FROM THEIR ASSIGNED POSITIONS. **THIS FEE COVERS NIGHT SECURITY FOR TWO NIGHTS.**
4. \$15.00 Grounds Fee is due on all horse & rider combinations and is to be paid with registration. All riders will pay the Grounds Fee with the exception of Leadline riders. ALL NON-SHOWING HORSES WILL PAY \$15.00 GROUNDS FEE.
5. SCHOOLING ON FRIDAY WILL BE OPEN TILL 5:30 PM FOR BOTH RINGS. NO SCHOOLING FOR RING 1 ON SATURDAY OR SUNDAY. WARM-UP CLASSES WILL BE OFFERED. NO SCHOOLING IN RING 2 SATURDAY. WARM-UP CLASSES WILL BE OFFERED. SCHOOLING IN RING 2 ON SUNDAY WILL CLOSE AT 8:00 AM. TIME PERMITTING AFTER SHOW ON SAT. SCHOOLING WILL BE ALLOWED TILL 5:30 PROMPTLY. NO EXCEPTIONS.
6. If two riders are entered, the class may be held and ribbons and end-of-year points awarded; however, to receive championship and reserve ribbons for that show, three riders must compete in the division. MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY TO COMPENSATE FOR EXCESSIVE OR INADEQUATE ENTRIES.
7. The Pensacola Hunter-Jumper Association will not be responsible for accident or injury to any rider, horse, attendant or equipment at this show. Under Florida law, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to, or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.
8. First thru 6<sup>th</sup> place ribbons will be awarded in each class. Championship award along with championship and reserve ribbons will be given for each hunter-jumper division at each show.
9. Class specifications: Every class is covered by the rules and specifications of this rule sheet and/or prize or pre-entry list. Should any question or dispute arise not provided for in the beforementioned rules, the same shall be submitted to the Committee whose decision shall be final.
10. All ponies must have a current PHJA measurement card. Ponies will be measured between 7:30 and 8:00 AM on Saturday. USEF permanent cards accepted.
11. Adults may ride their suitably-sized ponies. Any conflicts regarding suitability will be decided by the judge.
12. CLASS CONFLICTS MUST BE REPORTED by the rider or his agent to the paddock masters of ALL rings involved. Riders are to report as soon as possible to their classes. A MAXIMUM TIME FOR CLASS CONFLICTS OF 5 MINUTES COULD BE PUT INTO EFFECT IF NECESSARY.
13. Motorized vehicles must be operated by licensed drivers only and driven in a safe and non-disruptive manner.
14. A junior exhibitor is one who has not reached their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday before December 1<sup>st</sup> of the show year (the first day of the show year.) An Amateur is a person who has not received compensation for teaching, riding, training, showing or sales.
15. ANY ACT OF DISCOURTESY, CRUELTY OR DISOBEDIENCE ON THE PART OF THE RIDER, HIS AGENT OR REPRESENTATIVE OR TRAINER WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION AND ALL ENTRY FEES AND AWARDS SHALL BE FORFEITED.
16. Any exhibitor lodging a protest must deposit \$50 with the Secretary. All protests must be made before the end of the show, in writing, and signed by the protestor. The Committee reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising from or incidental to the show without claim for damages or recourse of any kind. Decisions are final.
17. In case of horses being entered and not exhibited, the entry fee will be forfeited. In the event of injury or illness of horse or rider, written notification, including veterinarian or doctor's certification will be necessary for a refund and must be received by the Secretary not later than 10 days after show date.
18. The Committee reserves the right to return or decline any entry fee or stabling fee before or during the show without being liable for compensation.
19. HARD HATS MUST BE WORN BY ALL RIDERS WHEN MOUNTED. THIS INCLUDES PRE-SHOW SCHOOLING. ALL HARD HATS MUST BE PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR PASSING TESTING STANDARDS; WITH CHIN STRAPS. PROPER ATTIRE IS REQUIRED WHEN ENTERING SHOW RING UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED BY THE JUDGE.
20. Should a horse be disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding award will be given the prize and the points originally awarded the disqualified horse.
21. No dogs allowed on the grounds unless they are on a leash and attended at all times. Owners of loose dogs are subject to a \$20.00 fine.
22. PHJA MEMBERS ONLY: Points will be awarded in divisions toward the PHJA annual high-point awards. To earn points, the owner of the horse in contention or the person leasing said horse must be a member in good standing of PHJA. Horse must also be registered before earning points. In the Equitation Division, the rider must be a member of PHJA in order to earn points. To earn points in the under-saddle classes, the horse must participate in at least one over-fence class in that division.  
(1<sup>st</sup> – 5 points; 2<sup>nd</sup> – 3 points; 3<sup>rd</sup> – 2 points; 4<sup>th</sup> – 1 point)
23. In the event of a tie for championship, the over-fence points will determine the winner. In case of a tie for end-of-year, there will be a work-off at the last show of the year to decide the championship. It is the responsibility of any member in contention for any end-of-year championship to be available for a work-off. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture.
24. A DIVISION MUST BE HELD FOR AT LEAST 2 SHOWS DURING THE YEAR TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR AN END-OF-YEAR CHAMPIONSHIP.
25. STALLIONS ARE NOT ALLOWED.
26. MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO MOVE CLASSES TO A DIFFERENT RING, COMBINE OR CANCEL CLASSES AND DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY FOR COMPLETING THE SHOW.

## **EQUITATION DIVISION**

To be judged on seat, hands and control. Except for refusals, jumping faults for the horse not to be considered unless it is the result of the rider's ability.

MARTINGALES NOT PERMITTED IN FLAT CLASSES.

**EQUITATION LEADLINE** – Open to early beginning riders age 6 or younger who have never shown in any other classes. Must be accompanied by a handler who will lead horse or pony at a walk. Rider to be judged. May enter only Leadline classes.

**EQUITATION WALK/TROT – 8 & UNDER** – Open to Junior riders. To be shown at a walk and trot both ways of the ring. Over-fences class may have 6 to 8 obstacles. The course will be trotted – must not canter. Riders may only enter Walk/Trot – 8 & Under classes.

**EQUITATION WALK/TROT – 9-15** – Open to Junior riders. To be shown at a walk and trot both ways of the ring. Over-fences class may have 6 to 8 obstacles. The course will be trotted – must not canter. Riders may only enter Walk/Trot – 9-15 classes.

**EQUITATION – MINI-STIRRUP** – Open to JUNIOR riders who have not jumped 2' or higher at any show. May only enter Mini-Stirrup classes. Fences 18".

**EQUITATION – SHORT STIRRUP** – Open to beginning riders age 12 and under who have never jumped more than 2' in shows. Riders only eligible to enter Short Stirrup classes and their equitation age group on the flat. Fences 2'.

**EQUITATION – LONG STIRRUP** – Open to beginning riders who have never jumped more than 2'3" in shows. Riders only eligible to enter Long Stirrup classes and their equitation age group on the flat. Fences 2'3".

**EQUITATION – PRE-CHILDREN/PRE-ADULT** – Open to all non-professional riders who have not jumped higher than 2'6" at any show. Fences 2'6".

**EQUITATION – 13 & UNDER** – Fences 2'6". Tests 1-8. **FENCE HEIGHTS WILL NOT BE CHANGED DURING THIS CLASS.**

**EQUITATION – 14-17** – Fences 3'. Tests 1-8.

**EQUITATION – ADULT** – Fences 2'6".- 2'9". Tests 1-18.

**PHJA MEDAL CLASS** – Fences 3'. Open to PHJA junior and non-professional members only. Horses only. The point system will determine the champion for the end-of-year award.

**PONY MEDAL CLASS** – Fences 2'3" – 2'6" – 2'9". Open to PHJA members only. The point system will determine the champion for the end-of-year award.

**EQUITATION – RUSTY STIRRUP** – Fences 2'. Open to non-junior and non-professional riders. Riders may enter Rusty Stirrup classes, Pleasure and Adult Equitation on the Flat. Horse & Rider Combination may not enter any other over-fences classes.

## **HUNTER DIVISION**

**UNDER-SADDLE CLASSES** – To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. MARTINGALES NOT PERMITTED.

**OVER-FENCES CLASSES** – To be judged on performance, even pace, manners, jumping style and way of moving.

**WALK/TROT HUNTER – 8 & UNDER** – Under-saddle class to be shown at a walk and trot both ways of the ring. Over-fence classes may have 6 to 8 obstacles. The course will be trotted—must not canter. Riders may only enter Walk/Trot – 8 & Under classes.

**Division sponsored by SWEAT TIRE**

**WALK/TROT HUNTER – 9-15** – Open to Junior riders. Under-saddle class to be shown at a walk and trot both ways of the ring. Over-fences classes may have 6 to 8 obstacles. The course will be trotted—must not canter. Riders may only enter Walk/Trot – 9-15 classes. Riders not to have 18" or higher in shows.

**MINI-STIRRUP HUNTER** – Open to JUNIOR riders who have not jumped 2' or higher at any show. Fences 18". MAY ONLY ENTER MINI STIRRUP CLASSES. Rider to trot X and canter verticals; includes change of direction. Simple change of lead permitted.

**Division sponsored by COAST ARCHITECTS, INC.**

**SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER** – Fences 2'. Open to riders age 12 and under. Riders may only enter Short Stirrup classes and their equitation age group on the flat. Riders not to have jumped 2' or higher in shows.

**LONG STIRRUP HUNTER** – Fences 2'3". Riders may only enter Long Stirrup classes.

And their equitation age group on the flat. Riders not to have jumped 2'3" or higher in shows.

Division sponsored by **HIS PLACE HORSE FARM**

**CROSS RAILS** – Intended for inexperienced riders and horses or for older horses and riders being retrained. Will be judged on consistence. Horse-and-rider combinations cannot enter any other over-fence classes. No Walk/Trot, Mini Stirrup, Short Stirrup or Long Stirrup riders allowed in these classes. Fences can be trotted or cantered. Under-saddle class walk, trot **and** canter. **First year of showing in Cross Rails** is not considered the first year of showing. Fences not to exceed 18".

**RUSTY STIRRUP HUNTER** -- Open to non-junior and non-professional riders. Intended for inexperienced riders and horses or for older horses being retrained. Fences 2'. Fences can be trotted or cantered. Will be judged on consistency. Riders may enter Rusty Stirrup classes, Hunter Pleasure and Adult Equitation on the Flat. Horse and Rider combination may not enter any other over-fences classes.

**INTERMEDIATE HUNTER – NO RESTRICTIONS.** Horse and rider combination may enter Baby Green if eligible. No restrictions as to previous showing. Fences 2'3".

Division sponsored by **GREEN BRANCH FARM**

**PRE-CHILDREN/PRE-ADULT HUNTER** -- Open to all non-professional riders who

have not jumped higher than 2'6" at any show. Under-saddle class to canter. Fences 2'6". May only cross enter into divisions of same fence heights.

Division sponsored by **GRAYTON FARM**

**BABY GREEN HUNTER** – Open to horses and ponies IN THE FIRST YEAR OF SHOWING OVER FENCES IN ANY DIVISION INCLUDING SHORT STIRRUP. Limited to one year. Fences 2'3". Horses may have shown one year in Cross Rails. May only cross enter into Schooling Hunter, Intermediate Hunter and rider's equitation age group on the flat..

Division sponsored by **PARKER ROOFING.**

**PRE-GREEN WORKING HUNTER** – Open to horses & ponies in their second or third year of showing that have not jumped a course of fences as high as 3' except Equitation or Pre-Green classes elsewhere. A horse is limited to two years in this section. 1<sup>ST</sup> YEAR FENCES 2'6" – 2<sup>ND</sup> YEAR FENCES 2'9".

**PONY WORKING HUNTER** – Suitable for and to be ridden by Juniors. All ponies must have current PHJA pony cards.

Small – not exceeding 12.2 hands – Fences 2'3"

Medium, - over 12.2 to 13.2 hands – Fences 2'6"

Large – over 13.2 to 14.2 hands – Fences 2'9"

Division sponsored by **PINE FOREST SADDLERY**

**SCHOOLING HUNTER** – Open to horses & ponies. No restrictions as to previous showing. Fences 2'6"

**LOW WORKING HUNTER** -- Open to horses & ponies. No restrictions as to previous showing. Fences 2'9".

**CHILDRENS HUNTER** – Open to Junior riders on horses or ponies. May not cross enter into Junior. Fences 2'6" – 2'9".

**ADULT HUNTER** – To be ridden by a non-professional individual who is no longer eligible to compete as a Junior rider. Fences 2'6" 2'9".

**JUNIOR WORKING HUNTER** – Open to Junior riders who have not reached their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday before December 1<sup>st</sup> of the show year (the first day of the show year.) May not cross enter into Childrens Hunter. Fences 3'.

Division sponsored by **HEATHERWOOD FARM**

**FIVE FLAGS HUNTER** -- Open to horses & ponies of any age. Not restricted by previous showing in any division. Fences 2'9" - 3'

#### **MISCELLANEOUS CLASSES**

**HUNTER PLEASURE** – Open to horses and ponies. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Martingales not permitted.

**LEADLINE HUNTER HACK** – Must be accompanied by a handler who will lead horse or pony at a walk over two ground poles. May only enter Leadline classes. Riders age 6 and under.

#### **JUMPER DIVISION**

**Class 1 -- BEGINNING JUMPER** – Fences 2'3" – 2'6" – OPEN TO ALL HORSES & RIDERS

**Class 2 – CHILDREN/AMATEUR JUMPER** – Fences 2'3" – 2'6"  
**OPEN TO JUNIOR/AMATEUR RIDERS**                      **SEE RULE 14**

**Class 3 -- SCHOOLING JUMPER** -- Fences 2'9" – 3' – OPEN TO ALL HORSES & RIDERS

**Class 4 -- OPEN JUMPER** – Fences 3' – 3'3" – OPEN TO ALL HORSES & RIDERS

To be shown over a course of 8 or more jumps with a maximum spread of 3'. Fences will not be raised in jump off. First round judged on faults. In case of a tie, the jump-off will be timed. Touches not to count.
